RESOLUTION SETTING THE ELECTION DATE FOR VOTE ON RESOLUTION 2020-18 RESOLUTION OF ANNEXATION

WHEREAS it appears to the Common Council of the City of Sturgis that more than 210 signatures have been received from qualified voters of the municipality of Sturgis, South Dakota to bring the following proposal to the voters for their approval or rejection pursuant to SDCL § 9-4-4.6; and

WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Sturgis on February 03, 2020 introduced and passed Resolution 2020-13 – Declaring the Intent to Extend the Boundaries of the City of Sturgis; and, on June 1, 2020, Resolution 2020-18 – Resolution of Annexation, was adopted by the Sturgis City Council; and the Resolution of Annexation was published on June 4, 2020 and would have been final on June 25, 2020; and, on June 24, 2020 petitions containing more than 210 signatures were received and verified by the Finance Officer; and

WHEREAS it appears to the Common Council that 210 valid signatures have been received on proper petitions referring the Resolution of Annexation to a vote of the people;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of Sturgis that the question of annexing the properties legally described in the Resolution of Annexation dated June 1, 2020, and more commonly known as the Jackpine Gypsies annexation shall be submitted to a vote of the people to be held at a special municipal election on August 4, 2020.
