The Sturgis Police Department is currently accepting applications for the volunteer position of Reserve Officer.

The Sturgis Police Reserves are a supplement to the Full-time Police Force and receive a minimum of 120 hours of training and 40 hours of ride along time before going out on patrol. They are certified with the State of South Dakota and are qualified to perform as Full-time Officers.

Once certified, Reserve Officers assist Full-time Officers in their daily functions with patrolling, crime scenes, traffic control and arrests. This is a great opportunity to gain valuable law enforcement experience with a respected department. Reserves are often hired during the annual Sturgis® Motorcycle Rally™ to support our law enforcement efforts.

Must be twenty-one (21) years of age



- Possess high school diploma or G.E.D. certification and a valid driver's license with acceptable driving record
- Must be able to build and maintain a good rapport with the general public
- Must have good communication skills (oral and written)
- There is no residency requirement for Reserve Officer applicants.
