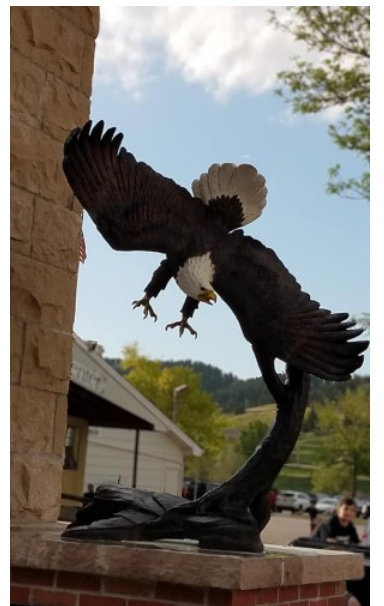

Official City Fireworks Set for July 3



City fireworks will take place on Wednesday, July 3 at dusk. The fireworks will be set off at the Fairgrounds on Ballpark Road.

City ordinance (Title 9) allows private use of fireworks from 8AM until 10PM on July 3 and from 8AM until 11PM on July 4. At no time shall a collapsible lantern or similar structure of thin paper or similar material, designed to be lit and then released into the air, be allowed for sale or use within the City of Sturgis or within one-mile of City limits. New language regarding clean-up was added to the City Ordinance in 2019. The new language states: *A person using or lighting fireworks which results in litter or debris landing on the property of another shall be responsible to clean up such litter and/or debris. An owner of property adjoining a dedicated right of way shall be responsible to clean up litter and debris in such right of way resulting from the use or lighting of fireworks, without regard to where the fireworks were lit.*

Music on Main in Full Swing

The first Music on Main event of 2019 was held on June 5 at Harley-Davidson Rally Point. 35th and Taylor entertained the crowd and 170 bicyclists took part in the race series sponsored by Regional Health. Music on Main, along with the Mountain Bike Race Series, will take place every Wednesday through July 24. This family-friendly event is free and open to the public. Racing and music begins at 6:00 PM.
