Consultants Seek Public Comment on Lakeside Water Park Design

The consulting firm of Fennel Designs was hired by the City to provide a preliminary design and cost estimates for the Lakeside Water Park. They are now ready to share their initial designs with the public.

On October 11 and 12 the public can stop by the Meade Room in the Community Center to view proposed designs and to offer input regarding various elements of the park. Consultants will be on site to explain the concepts and to keep track of the questions and comments. Following the input period, the consultants will work on incorporating as many ideas as possible into the final design plans.

The Aquatics Committee is currently in the process of fundraising for outdoor aquatic activities. If approved, the adventure park will include amenities for all ages. The man-made lake will feature play structures and a beach. The area surrounding the lake may include a splashpad, a concession area, a miniature golf course, and picnic areas. The park will be surrounded by a bike/walking trail.

A limited number of housing units may also be located near the park. The housing area will provide a significant source of funding for the project.

Community Center Upgrades

The Sturgis Community Center will have scheduled upgrades taking place October 25 through November 30.

Work includes new plaster surfacing for the pool, and the installation of new lockers in both locker rooms. The pool, sauna, hot tub, and locker rooms will be closed during construction. Other areas of the Community Center will remain open.



Two New Events Scheduled in October

The Sturgis Rally and Events Department are pleased to announce two new events this fall.

The Streets of Sturgis Criterium will take place in downtown Sturgis on October 2. The Criterium is open to all bicycles, all levels of expertise, and all ages. All races are held on a closed track on the streets of downtown Sturgis.



The Forest Frenzy Gravel Grinder will be held on October 3. Gravel grinders are bicycle gravel road races and rides that combine riding on surfaces such as asphalt, gravel, and dirt, along with single-track trails, and ORV

roads.

The race includes a 25-mile fun ride as well as 47-mile and 64-mile timed race. All events will start and finish at Harley-Davidson Rally Point.

City-Wide Fall Cleanup October 4-8

The Sturgis City-Wide Fall Clean-Up will take place October 4-8. During this time, you may place unwanted items on the boulevard near your trash tote **before your regular pick-up day**, and the City will pick them up for disposal. If you share a 300-gallon tote in an alley, place your items alongside the alley near your property.

Please sort your items into separate piles.

- **White Goods: Metal, Appliances, Bicycles, etc.**

Appliances **must** have a signed EPA form attached. All freon **must** be removed from appliances before placing the item out for pick-up. EPA forms are available at the Public Works Department.

- **Untreated Lumber**

- **Rubble: Furniture, Building Materials, Etc.**

Branches can be taken to the Rubble Site year around, free of charge (with a current water bill) during regular site hours, or you may place them in the yard waste bin at the Exit 32 recycling area.

Several trucks will be collecting items. They will try to follow the regularly scheduled pick-up day; however, they may run behind schedule due to the extra loads that week.

Some restrictions apply - Sanitation crews will not pick up tires, paint, batteries, treated lumber, or items containing freon. For a complete listing of things that qualify for removal, visit the Public Works page on the city website sturgis-sd.gov or call the Public Works Office at 347-3916.



Did You Know?

Storm drains are commonly labeled to remind people that when liquids enter these drains they end up in our waterways downstream. Those waterways provide habitat to a diverse number of animals and other organisms.

It is illegal to dump paint, fuel, cleaning products, grease and any other liquid into a storm drain.
