Construction of Shade Structure Underway at Rally Point



On April 17, construction crews began work to replace columns at Harley-Davidson Rally Point Plaza. The engineered columns are required to support a new solar shade structure.

The combined 40-watt solar panel and shade structure is scheduled for installation this spring. The solar panel will generate electricity that will supplement the electricity currently being used at the Sturgis Library. The structure will also provide much needed shade at the plaza.

In late May, Harley-Davidson Way in front of the Plaza will be closed for a period of time while the shade is assembled in the street prior to being lifted into place on the new columns. The shade is scheduled to be in place and functioning by the second week in June.
